



NOTICE

Kindly be advised of the following arrangements pertaining to the applications for admission for the 2025 academic year.

First – year applicants

1. Applications for admission for the 2025 academic year will commence on Monday, 06 May 2024 and will close on **30 September 2024**; except for the following programmes which will close on **31 July 2024**:

- *Bachelor of Education in senior phase and FET Teaching*
- *Diploma in Safety Management*
- *Diploma in Labour Law*
- *Diploma in Information Technology*
- *Diploma in Logistics*
- *Diploma in Agricultural Management*
- *Bachelor of Health Sciences*

2. Applicants who apply for the Diploma in any of the Engineering programmes but do not qualify for the main stream Diploma will automatically be evaluated and considered for the extended Diploma in the equivalent Engineering Diploma. Please note that the extended programme has a minimum time of four years.

3. Where an applicant has already completed their grade 12, has their final grade 12 results and meets the minimum admission requirements; an offer will be made to the applicant, to which an acceptance or decline of offer must be made by logging on to the student iEnabler. The applicant will have four days to either accept or decline the offer, failing which if no response is received, the offer will automatically expire, and the applicant will be automatically rejected by the system. This offer will be sent via the email address that is on the system.

4. Applicants who will be applying using results from a Technical and Vocational Education and Training Colleges (TVET Colleges), should follow this process once an application is submitted.

Be reminded that registration is and will always be on a first-come, first-served basis. Spaces are limited to the quota set per programme. Therefore, the acceptance of an offer does not automatically guarantee registration.

Senior applicants

Applications for all other programmes from advanced diploma to PhD will also open on 06 May 2024. The closing dates for these will be communicated during the year.

Payment of the application fee

1. The application handling/administration fee is required on an annual basis as the payment is done for each academic year in which an application is made. For example: for applications made for the 2024 academic year – whether these were done in 2023 or during the late applications period in early 2024, the application fee paid was for administration of the applications made for the 2024 academic year.

2. VUT will therefore require that all applications made for the 2025 academic year be accompanied by the application fee. The fees are charged for the 2025 academic year as follows:

2.1. National applicants: R110 – use your student number as a reference when making payment. **Do not use any other information for your reference (DO NOT use your surname or ID Number)**

2.2. International applicants: R120 – use your student number as a reference when making payment. **Do not use any other information for your reference (DO NOT use your surname or home ID number or passport number)**

3. Application fees that will be considered are those paid for and received after the commencement of the application period. Application fees paid before 06 May 2024 will not be considered.
