

## SERVICES / PROJECTS RENDERED

- Compile a data-base for all staff and students with disabilities.
- Offer advice on teaching and learning methods to teaching and academic staff seeking support in this area.
- Produce academic/ university related material for people with disabilities in accessible formats.
- Recruitment of volunteers.
- Involvement to improve the physical accessibility on campus for all persons with disabilities.
- Sign language interpreting for people with hearing impairment, including note taking and other assistive measures.
- Assistance with registration, bursary and loan applications and interviews, as well as individual administrative support.
- Networking with organisations for people with disabilities including institutions of higher learning and the community in general regarding training, advice and support.
- Registration with Disability Services Unit as soon as possible after registering with VUT and provide the relevant documentation e.g. a letter from a doctor or hospital confirming disability.
- Training.
- Exam concessions.
- Liaison with academic staff.
- Referrals.
- Adapted study material.

To ensure that VUT increasingly becomes an accessible Higher Education Institution for people with disabilities.


## MISSION

## PURPOSE

- To offer reasonable accommodation for people with disabilities in all areas of university life, if not immediately, but on an incremental basis.
- To foster positive and empathetic attitudes towards people with disabilities
- To provide individuals with the choice at registration/employment to disclose their disability or not, in line with relevant legislation.
- To progressively ensure that all future buildings, renovations, facilities, and services provided by the university comply with universal design principals
- To ensure incremental basis on the University design, layout, parking and access to its buildings (including private accommodation and leased facilities) accommodate the need of people with disabilities
- To provide for the establishment of a Disability Services Unit that will provide dedicated support services to people with disabilities.
- To promote equity for people with disabilities which implies access to courses, buildings, learning material, residences, leisure and sport activities opportunities.
